
EARTH DAY TRASH BASH & CLOPPER MILL VISIT

We are pleased to be partnering again with the Izaak Walton League of America -Rockville Chapter, to clean accumulated trash from near the ruins of Seneca's own Clopper Mill. This is a unique opportunity to SAFELY hike (and bushwhack) to the mill ruins from the IWLA parking area off Clopper Road. The Ikes will provide **lunch from the grill** after the event.



WHEN: Sunday, April 22^{nd} , 9:00 – 12:00 Everyone is invited to stay for lunch afterwards.

WHERE: 12087 Clopper Road, Gaithersburg. There is a yellow gate on the right (east) side of Clopper Road northbound, just before the bridge over Great Seneca Creek. Park near the lake.

WHAT TO WEAR: Please wear heavy duty hiking clothes, sturdy shoes and bring gardening gloves. There are no paths near the mill, so much of the actual clean up will be done in the "wild".

WHAT TO BRING: Bottled water. Trash bags will be supplied. Camera for the mill ruins.

WHY: Much trash has accumulated along the banking between Clopper Road and the mill ruins. Some of this debris washes into Great Seneca Creek with every rainstorm. Help the Earth, save wildlife and our waterways.
